4. How We Will Process Your Child's Documents

Step 1: Redaction

We will remove all personal information (names, addresses, phone numbers, school names, etc.) from the documents using professional redaction software. This protects your child's privacy.

Step 2: AI-Assisted Analysis

The redacted documents will be analysed using Claude AI (made by Anthropic) to identify patterns in how your child learns, processes information, and demonstrates

strengths. Only redacted documents are shared with AI - never the originals with personal details.

Step 3: Profile Creation

Our learning facilitator will create a comprehensive cognitive strengths profile using established cognitive frameworks to identify your child's unique learning strengths, combining the AI analysis with professional expertise.

Step 4: Capacity Assessment

We will assess whether DLC can appropriately support your child's learning needs based on their profile.

Step 5: Secure Destruction

All original and redacted documents will be securely destroyed within 30 days of completing your child's profile. Only the final profile is kept.

5. Understanding DLC's Capacity

DLC is designed to support children aged 7-16 with diverse cognitive profiles through:

- Strengths-based, individualised learning approaches
- Different MIND reasoning types and processing speeds
- Small group collaborative work (6-8 children)
- Varied learning styles and preferences

However, as a small learning community, DLC cannot provide:

- Intensive 1:1 specialised behavioural intervention throughout the day
- Clinical therapeutic or mental health support
- Specialised autism programmes (e.g., ABA, intensive sensory programmes)
- Medical management or crisis intervention beyond basic first aid
- Full-time care for severe anxiety, self-regulation challenges, or complex trauma

This doesn't mean your child needs to be "easy"! We welcome children who struggled in traditional schools because those environments didn't match their cognitive strengths. We just want to be transparent about what we can and cannot provide.

If your child's profile suggests support needs beyond DLC's capacity, we will discuss this with you openly before making any placement decisions.

6. Your Rights and Data Protection

Your child's information is protected under UK GDPR and the Data Protection Act 2018. You have the right to:

- Access all information we hold about your child
- Request corrections to inaccurate information
- Request deletion of your child's data

- • Withdraw your consent at any time
- • Receive a copy of your child's profile

Withdrawing Consent: You can withdraw your consent at any time by emailing or writing to us. If you withdraw consent, we will securely destroy all documents and profiles within 72 hours and confirm this to you in writing.

7. Safeguarding

If our community members identify any safeguarding concerns whilst reviewing your child's documents, we have a legal duty to report these to our Designated Safeguarding Lead. In cases of immediate risk to your child, we may need to contact children's social care or police. Your child's safety always comes first.
